REFLECTION: The Feeding of the Five Thousand is the only miracle recounted in all four Gospels. Today Luke tells of Jesus ordering the crowd into parties of fifty. St Luke likes order! The arrangement reminds us this miracle is a foreshadowing of the Eucharist, the same Eucharist we celebrate today in memory of the Lord. Let us too be ordered in our celebration.

OUR DAILY MASSES ARE TAKEN FROM THE TWELFTH WEEK OF THE YEAR EXCEPT:

FEASTS: Mon. 24th **The Nativity of St John the Baptist:** Son of Zachary and Elizabeth, he led a life of austerity and penance in the desert, proclaiming a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. He was humble yet strong and prepared his people to receive the Lord. Jesus described him "of all children born to women, there is no greater than John".
Tues. 25th **St Luan or Moluag (6th cent):** A monk of the great monastery at Bangor in Co. Down and a contemporary of St Columba, he too came to Scotland where he preached the Gospel to the Picts on Lismore and in Ross-shire. Venerated as the Patron Saint of Argyll where today his feast is still celebrated, he built many Churches which he dedicated to Our Lady and St Bernard of Clairvaux attests to his founding no less than one hundred monasteries. He died in 592.

Fri. 28th: **Solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus:** The feast reminds us of the Heart of Jesus the shepherd of his flock, a compassionate Heart tending wounds and seeking the strays, a joyful Heart rejoicing in the return of the lost.

Sat. 29th **The Immaculate Heart of Mary:** The mystery of the love of the Heart of Jesus is mirrored in the Heart of His Mother, Mary. She is his greatest follower and disciple.

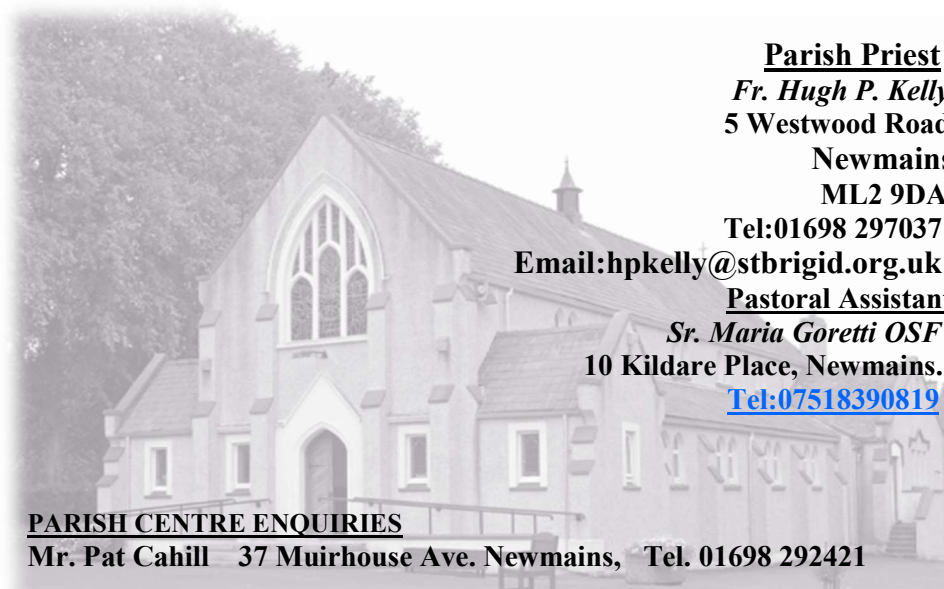
