REFLECTION: Our Liturgy this Sunday is like being on a roller-coaster! We begin by waving branches and singing Hosanna but it is not long till we hear the shouts "Crucify Him, Crucify Him" being called out to the very one shortly before being lauded as King! The people of Jerusalem were a fearful and fickle bunch. The Apostles were not much better, and now in Holy Week we test our own reaction to the swell of emotion the Holy Week Liturgy brings.

HOLY WEEK PROGRAMME: Our Masses from Monday to Wednesday are the Masses of Holy Week.

The Easter Vigil will begin at **8.00pm** and on Easter Morning there will be Mass at **11am.**
